Recognition of B.Ed. Course by NCTE

In 2005 NCTE (ER) granted recognition to Ranchi Women's College, Ranchi for starting B.Ed. course of one year duration from the academic session 2005-2006 and onwards with an annual intake of 100 (one hundred) students vide letter no. ERC/7-56.11(5)/2005/1486 (1) dated 12 May 2005 after "No Objection" by the Department of Human Resource Development, State Government of Jharkhand (Letter no. 1658 dated 23.06.2004). Recognition of our Institution has been further continued by NCTE (ERC) Bhubaneshwar vide letter no. ERC/7-193.12(i). 5/ERC APE00287/2015/35259 dt. 31/08/2015.

Two Year's B.Ed. Course from 2015

ERC, NCTE has continued recognition for B.Ed. Course of two year's duration from 2015 as per Proceedings of 191st Meeting of ERC-NCTE held on 14th -15th July, 2015 under clause : 59 : 191.12.28 (Ranchi Women's College, Circular Road, Ranchi, Jharkhand-834001 (B.Ed.) (Constituent Unit) (Ranchi University) (Code No.APE00287).

Duration and Working Days

Duration

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The B.Ed. programme shall be of a duration of two academic years, which can be completed in a maximum of three years from the date of admission to the programme.

Working Days

- (a) There shall be at least two hundred working days each year exclusive of the period of examination and admission.
- (b) The institution shall work for a minimum of thirty six hours in a week (five or six days), during which physical presence in the institution of all the teachers and student teachers is necessary to ensure their availability for advice, guidance, dialogue and consultation as and when needed.
- (c) The minimum attendance of student-teachers shall have to be 80% for all course work and practicum and 90% for school internship.

Intake

There shall be a basic unit of 50 students, with a maximum of two units. There shall not be more than twenty five student per teacher for a school subject for methods courses and other practical activities of the programme to facilitate participatory teaching and learning.

Eligibility

(a) Candidates with at least fifty percent marks either in the Bachelor's Degree and/or in the Master's Degree in Sciences/Social Sciences/Humanity, Bachelor's in Engineering or Technology with specialization in Science and Mathematic with 55% marks or any other qualification equivalent thereto, are eligible for admission to the programme.

(b) The reservation and relaxation for SC/ST/OBC/PWD and other categories shall be as per the rules of the Central Governement / State Government, whichever is applicable.

Minimum Age Bar:

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The applicant ought to be of 18 years on 1st August of current session.

New Course Structure as per NCTE

As per NCTE 2014 Regulation the two year B.Ed. programme comprises of three broad inter related curricular areas : a) Perspectives in Education

- b) Curriculum and Pedagogic Studies
- c) Engagement with the field.

It also includes special course for enhancing professional capacities (EPC) of student teachers. The courses under the above mentioned areas are distributed semester wise as follows:

Rules and Regulations

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- 1. A student admitted to B.Ed. Course in colleges must maintain an ethos of commitment to a professional programme. She is expected to behave in dignified manner in the college campus.
- 2. The trainees must attend all demonstration classes during the course as well as her scheduled practice teaching classes as per Academic Calendar. She is expected to teach in the school assigned to her by the college duly approved by the DEO, Ranchi.
- 3. Prior permission is required from the Principal / Coordinator, B.Ed. for any absence either from theory or practical classes and community life activities. Application for leave should be in writing mentioning reason of leave/absence.
- 4. No other commitments, such as competitive examination, computer course, private tuition, university examination should be undertaken during the regular college timings of classes and activities.
- 5. Every student is expected to make the best use of books in the Library.
- 6. The trainees are expected to take proper care of the college property.
- 7. If a candidate wants to drop out from the course before the commencement of classes, she will receive refund of fee except admission fee & admissible charges. After one month of the commencement of classes there will be no refund of money.
- 8. UNIFORM : Students should come to the College in College Uniform only. Dress Code (College Uniform) is mandatory.
- 9. MOBILE: Use of Cell Phone / Mobile inside the College Building is not allowed. If any student is found using mobile phones inside the Class Room, Corridor or office of the College, her phone will be seized followed by other disciplinary action which may lead to CLC .
- 10. IDENTITY CARD & PROSPECTUS: Every Student will have to carry her Identity Card and Prospectus (Specially rules and regulation's pages) when she is in the College. She will not be given entry in the College without her Identity Card.
- 11. TWO WHEELER: If any student comes by Two-Wheeler, she will have to submit the copy of her Date of Birth, Driving License and an undertaking that she will always use Helmet; She will never ride without Helmet; She will never ride with more than one person at pillion.
- 12. NOTICE BOARD: Every student will have to develop the habit of watching College Notice Board every time she enters the College and leaves the College.
- 13. ORNAMENT/JEWELLERY: No student is permitted to put on ornaments or jewellery.
- 14. SITTING ON VEHICLES: Students should not sit on any vehicle parked in the Campus. o one should use any parked vehicle as Table to write anything. If found guilty the student may be fined Rs.50/-.
- 15. MALE MEMBER: These days it is found that students invite male members of the family or male friends to the college campus. If any student is seen talking for a long time after she has been dropped in the college Campus, this will be reported to her Parents with a fine of Rs. 100/-.

NOTE: A selected applicant who is already enrolled in another regular course elsewhere shall not be allowed to continue both regular courses simultaneously.

Anti Ragging Rules & Undertakings: BAN ON RAGGING

This College is reputed for excellent teaching and strict discipline. It has formed a Proctorial Board that looks after proper maintenance of discipline and leaves no scope for ragging.

Anybody found involved in any type of humiliating behaviour leading to ragging will be expelled from the college after the decision of the Proctorial Board. Besides, FIR will be lodged against those students who will be found exercising ragging and bullying on the campus or around the campus.

What is Ragging:

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Any disorderly conduct whether by words spoken or written or by an act of which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness any other student, indulging in rowdy or harm or to raise fear or apprehension there of in a fresher or a junior student or asking the student to do nay act or perform something which such student of causing or generating a sense of shame or embracement no as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of a fresher of a junior student.

Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established by the Proctorial Board of the college, the possible punishment for those found guilty of ragging at the institution level shall be any one or any combination of the following:

Punishment at the Institution level for Ragging

- (i) Cancellation of admission
- (ii) Suspension from attending classes
- (iii) Withholding/Withdrawing scholarship/fellowship & other benefits.
- (iv) Debarring from appearing in any test examination or other evaluation process
- (v) Withholding results.
- (vi) Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, your festival etc.
- (vii) Rustication form the institution for period ranging from one semester / 6 months.
- (ix) Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring form the admission to any other institution.
- (x) Fine of Rs. 25,000/- to Rs. 1 Lakh.
- (xi) Collective punishment: When the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deferent to ensure community pressure on the potential raggers.
